



Young Artists' Gallery 2020

Overview:

The Young Artists' Gallery is a juried art exhibit and contest open to high school students of Miami Dade county public schools. The Woman's Club of Coconut Grove established YAG in 2001 as an annual event designed to provide exhibition opportunities for talented high school art students, to learn about careers in the visual arts and to offer support and encouragement for young talent by giving them the opportunity to show their work to art patrons and to see how their work can be marketable. **The Woman's Club awards over \$10,000 in scholarships to deserving students every year.** The Art Education Office of Dade County pre-judges the artworks submitted and selects the finalists, which will be displayed at the Woman's Club of Coconut Grove March 14-15. The artists in the exhibit will be able to offer their work for sale if they wish. Finalists and scholarship winners will be honored at a prestigious awards reception held at the club Saturday, March 14th from 2:00 to 4:00PM.

Location of the exhibit:

The Woman's Club of Coconut Grove (founded in 1891) in the heart of Coconut Grove. Corner of South Bayshore Drive and McFarlane: 2985 South Bayshore Drive, Coconut Grove, FL 33133

Eligibility:

The Young Artists' Gallery is open to high school students from Miami-Dade County Public Schools. Accepted media : Watercolor, oil, acrylic, drawing, collage, mix-media, sculpture, ceramics, printmaking and digital.

Awards:

The Woman's Club will award each exhibiting student artist a Certificate of Participation and several scholarships ranging from \$1,500 to \$3,000. Ten students will also receive Merit Awards of Distinction and \$50 Checks. The teachers of all winning students will receive an honorarium of \$50 as well.

Art Sale:

Students can offer their pieces for sale during the exhibit to eager local art patrons. Prices must not exceed \$200. The students will receive checks made out to them for their sales at the end of the show. There is no cost to the students to participate.

Artwork Drop-off and Pickup:

Accepted entries need to be delivered to the Art Education Office, 9607/Art Education/316/Annex "Young Artists' Gallery 2020" by Thursday, February 20, 2020. After the exhibit, all artworks will be delivered to the schools the following week.

Submission of entries Step by Step:

1. Students must submit their work to their art teachers in the following medium: Watercolor, oil, acrylic, drawing, collage, mix-media, sculpture, ceramics, printmaking and digital.
2. Teachers must select up to 10 pieces of student artwork to submit.
 - Only 1 entry per student (different teachers may submit the same student)
3. Teachers must submit the selected works electronically by Midnight on Thursday, January 30, 2020
 - JPEG image (no larger than 3.32 MB)

4. Teachers and students prepare the accepted entries:
 - Work must be submitted in a form in which it can be exhibited - matted or framed
 - Complete the enclosed inventory sheet.
 - If the students wish to sell their art, they must also complete a permission slip enclosed and staple the form to the inventory sheet. Prices must not exceed \$200. The students will receive checks made out to them for their sales at the end of the show. There is no cost to the students to participate.
 - Tape the information page generated from the digital submissions to the **back** of the works
 - All artwork labels must be **TYPED** and adhered to the **front** bottom right hand corner of the mat or frame

5. Accepted entries and forms are then placed in a labeled portfolio (one portfolio per teacher) and sent to the Art Education Office, 9607/Art Education/316/ Annex “Young Artists’ Gallery 2020” by Thursday, February 20, 2020

Judging:

Entries will be pre-judged by the Art Education Office in early February. The accepted entries will be showcased in the YAG 2020 exhibit March 14-15, 2020. An independent panel of judges chosen by the Woman’s Club will then judge the works and select the scholarship winners and the Merit Award winners. Previous years’ judges have included local artists, museum directors, and gallery owners. Works will be judged according to presentation, artistic merit, creativity, and excellence.
